REPORT OF HEARING OFFICER

This represents the independent report of The Hearing officer Hon. Judge James F. Henry (Ret.) a former Judge of The Circuit Court of Cook County. The hearing was timely commenced and all interested parties were given an opportunity to present their opinions and suggestions. Also, the Hearing Officer advised all present to transmit written comments to The CPS by 5:00 p.m., Monday April 22, 2013 if they wished.

INTRODUCTION

The purpose of the hearing was to receive public comments from both representatives of CPS, specifically Ms. Jaculin Jerman-Milovich an attorney for The Chicago Public Board of Education's Law Department; Cory Davis, Director of Capital Renovation and New Construction; and Ashley Richardson, a Portfolio Planner for Chicago Public Schools who has obtained a Masters of Education Policy and Management from the Harvard Graduate School of Management.

Member of Local School Councils, parents of the schools' students, member of the staffs, the Principals, students and any other interested party were invited to participate.

Notice of The Public Hearings were served on the parents, teachers, staff, Principals and members of the Local School Councils of the affected schools via U.S. Mail as well as local elected officials, as required by Illinois Law and/or applicable policies of the Boards Guidelines and procedure. Notice by Publication was also served by publication in The Chicago Sun Times (CPS Exhibits in evidence Exh. 3,4,5 and 6).

No additional written comments were in fact timely received after the meeting by 5:00 p.m. April 22, 2013.

SUMMARY OF PUBLIC COMMENTS

* **MR. CHRISTOPHER GOINS:** He is the principal intern with Noble and indicated there is a strong parent demand for the services provided for the educational opportunities their school provide. Also, Noble has begun an outreach to the community and in the process of hiring staff and recruiting families.

Mr. Goins thanked Corliss Principal Mr. Harris who has been receptive for the collaboration.

FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS & RECOMMENDATIONS


